TOWN OF CARMAN WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY RATES
Effective Jan 1, 2025

NOTICE is given that The Public Utilities Board, in Board Order No. 138/22, has approved the Pembina Valley Water Coop pass through water rates, effective January 1, 2024, and January 1, 2025, January 1st, 2026 and January 1st, 2027. A copy of the complete board order may be reviewed at the Town of Carman office, 12-2nd Avenue SW, Carman.

As per the Board Order, please be advised the Town of Carman is required to follow the following directives ordered by the Public Utilities Board in this order.

Carman Water and Wastewater Utility, BE AND HEREBY VARIED in accordance with the attached Schedule A, effective April 1st, 2024, January 1, 2025, and January 1, 2026, and January 1st, 2027.

The Town of Carman is to provide a notice of the decisions at least 90 days prior to its customers or as soon as possible, with a copy to the Public Utilities Board.

The Town of Carman amend its water and wastewater rate By-law to reflect the decisions in this Order and submit a copy to the Board once it has received third and final reading.
