10cm (4")

ice fishing,

12cm (5")

one vehicle -
 ATV or snowmobile,
 or one large group
 of people

20-30cm
 (8-12")

one vehicle -
 car or light truck

30-38cm
 (12-15")

one vehicle -
 medium truck or SUV





A friendly reminder from your Public Works Department

With the return of the snow, we would like to remind residents that the Town strives to plow and sand all roads in a timely manner. The downtown area is cleared next and once this is complete, crews move to the residential areas, starting with avenues and then moving to streets.

Please do your part to help the crews clear the streets by removing all parked vehicles from the street during or as soon after a snow fall event. *This will allow the crew to provide efficient snow removal as quickly as possible. If vehicles are on the street when equipment arrives, they will be towed at the expense of the owner.*
