# Free Kicksled Lending Program

4 Day loan - Pickup Friday before 4:00 pm and drop off Tuesday before 4:00 pm. Pick up is across the arena. Kicksleds are 6 feet long, you will need a big enough vehicle to load it up. Waivers need to be filled out at the office.

KICKSLED SIZE CHART:  
Please note that the size chart is indicative. The size of a kicksled is chosen based on the height of the person who is going to kick or to push the sled, their weight does not matter. The larger the kicksleds are 71" long.

MEDIUM	T4 4'0" - 5'1"	30"
LARGE	T6 5'0" - 5'9"	34"

# A friendly reminder from your Public Works Department

With the return of the snow, we would like to remind residents that the Town strives to plow and sand all roads in a timely manner. The downtown area is cleared next and once this is complete, crews move to the residential areas, starting with avenues and then moving to streets.

Please do your part to help the crews clear the streets by removing all parked vehicles from the street during or as soon after a snow fall event. *This will allow the crew to provide efficient snow removal as quickly as possible. If vehicles are on the street when equipment arrives, they will be towed at the expense of the owner.*

*Please be patient, your street will be cleared as soon as possible!*
