Sawdust, shavings

Compostable bags

Plain bread

Grass clippings

Tea bags / Tea leaves

Coffee grinds with filters

Pasta, rice, baked goods

Feathers

Soft stem plants

Seafood shells

Vegetable trimmings

Food soiled paper uncoated

Egg shells

Fruit scraps (peels, pits, seeds)

Weeds

Paper plates, napkins, etc.

Old potting soil

Twigs (less than 1/4 Cm in diam)

UN-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Metals

Meat, fish, poultry & bones

Dairy products

Sauces (Cheese, meat or other)

Pet waste & cat litter

Trash

Fats & oils
