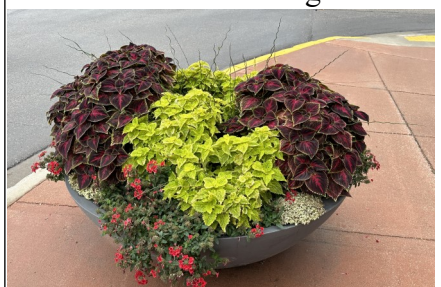
**Fire Prevention Week**

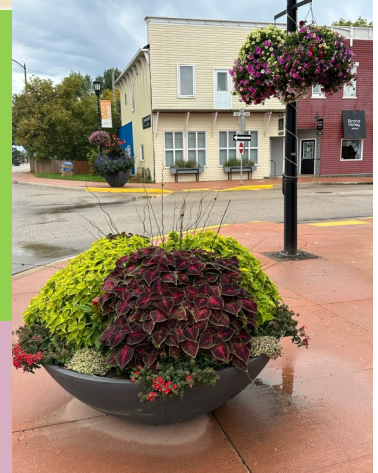

# Utilities & What You Need To Know

## Friendly Reminders

- Town of Carman utility accounts are billed quarterly. You can expect your quarterly bill to arrive in early April, July, October and January. If you have not received your bill, please contact us at [204-745-2443](tel:204-745-2443) to verify your mailing information.
- When paying your utility bill through online banking, please ensure that you are selecting the correct payee (Town of Carman – Utilities) and that your account number matches the account number on your current utility invoice. Most banks require 4+ Digits for our accounts, please omit the “0” at the beginning and do not include the decimal.
- If payment isn’t received by due date on invoice, an interest of 1.25% will be added each additional month your account carries a balance.
- If your utility account has a balance outstanding as of December 1st, 2024 that balance will be transferred to your tax account.
- If you are moving, please contact our office and notify our staff so we can assure your final water bill will be prepared in a timely manner .

## For Landlords ....

- We are in the process of upgrading our billing system to provide both landlords and tenants with a copy of their quarterly utility invoices. This will assist property owners in monitoring the status of their tenants' utility payments and help ensure accounts remain up to date.
- While adding tenants to the utility account is offered as a courtesy, the ultimate responsibility for ensuring all that charges are paid in full rests with the property owner.
